



## Project Profile 049

- **Contract:** Cold Hiendley Reservoir
- **Brief description:** Modifications to spillway and strengthening of footbridge
- **Client:** UK Coal Ltd



### Works carried out include:

- SES were contracted to undertake the modifications to the dam spillway. The purpose of the works was to mitigate the risk of the reservoir dam collapsing by lowering the level of the water. A new base and walls were constructed as part of the modifications.
- SES were also contracted to strengthen a footbridge adjacent to the reservoir. The footbridge is used by the public and is on a route popular with walkers and cyclists.
- Cold Hiendley Reservoir is the habitat for a variety of wildlife, flora and fauna, requiring significant sensitive environmental considerations and conservation, which SES managed successfully. The reservoir is very popular with visitors and SES managed the interface between the public and the construction works.
- SES were presented with a challenging environment, which required due consideration of the safety of the workforce, public and others, within a sensitive working area.



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
